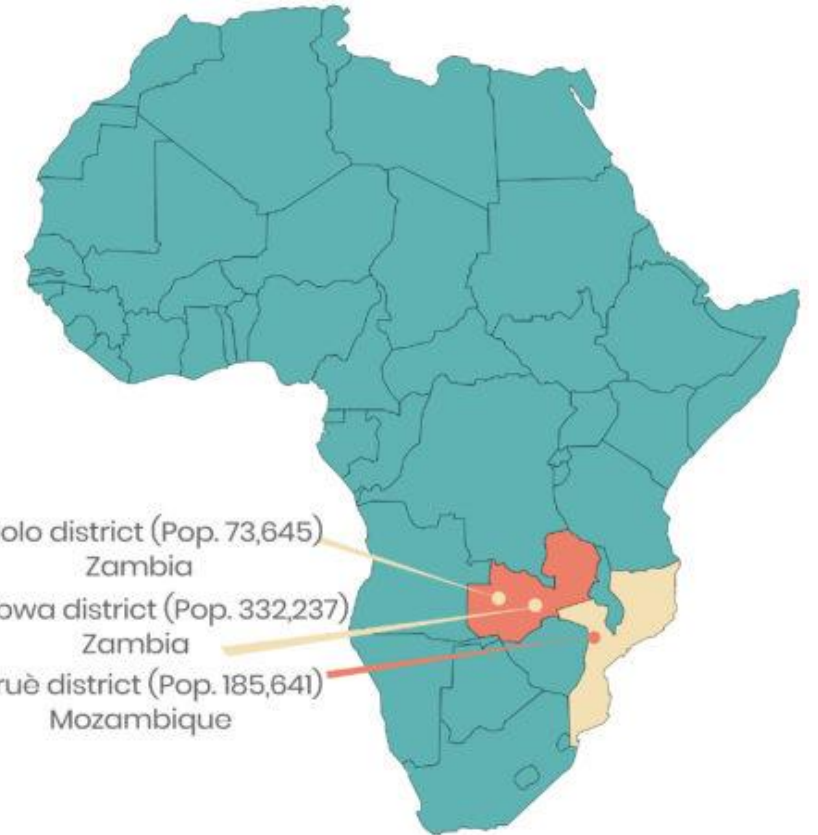


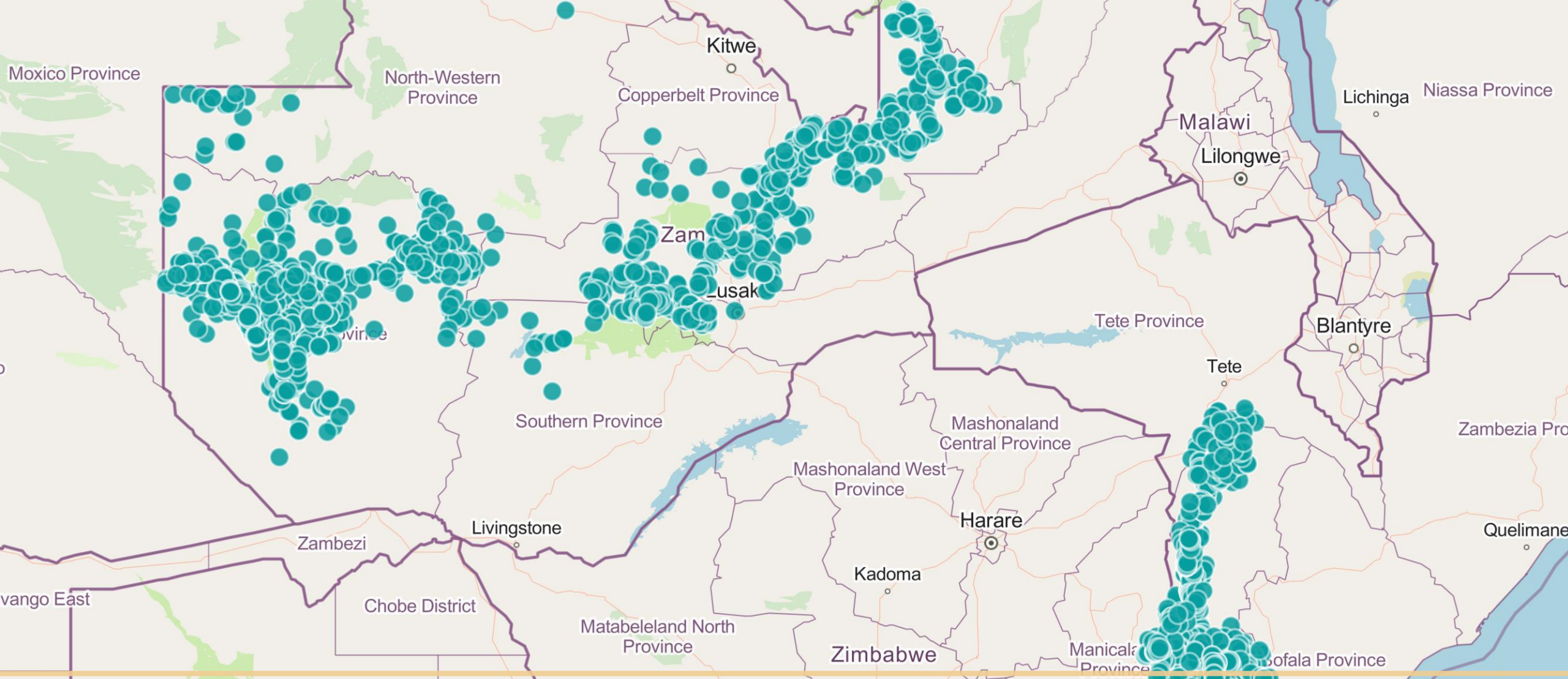

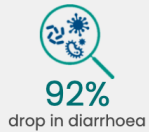

Field staff collect data quarterly

Data is collected on a live mobile-to-web system so we can track improvements and flag issues from the UK

Rather than report village by village we sample huge amounts of data to show change at District level

Rehab projects have 5-year monitoring built in

What's next

- **Continue with masterplan development. Nalolo, Mumbwa and Manica implementations are in full swing. We are measuring our impact and scaling up activities to help the districts reach the goal of 100% coverage.**
- **Reach over 600,000 people between 2024-2030 across 3 districts to reach 100% coverage**
- **Long-term campaign to fundraise for each partner to have their own drilling rig – we'd like to partner with Rotary Clubs over the world to achieve this.**
